THE HOLY TRINITY IN DAILY WORSHIP

“I believe in one God, the Father Almighty...and in one Lord Jesus Christ...and in the Holy Spirit.” Nicene Creed

God- Father, Son and Holy Spirit- plays an important role in the life and the worship of the Orthodox Christian and the Church. We make the sign of the cross with the thumb and first two fingers representing the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We bring these fingers together to signify that we believe not in three Gods but in one God. The last two fingers are placed in our palm signifying that we believe that Jesus Christ in two natures- perfect God and perfect man. We are baptized in the name of the Holy Trinity: we are forgiven in the name of the Holy Trinity; we are married in the name of the Holy Trinity; every Divine Liturgy begins with the name of the Holy Trinity: “Blessed is the Kingdom of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, now and forever and to the ages of ages;” we bless and are blessed in the name of the Holy Trinity: “Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit” and “the Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God the Father and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all;” every Divine Liturgy we confess our faith in the Holy Trinity when we say in the Nicene Creed: “I believe in one God, the Father Almighty...and in one Lord Jesus Christ...and in the Holy Spirit.” All prayers in the Orthodox Church are addressed to the Holy Trinity, One God revealed in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We pray to God the Father through our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Spirit.
